# About the Trust

### **Tuition Fees & other Charges:**

Fees is collected in the school fees counter. Online Fees payment facility is also available from class L.N. onwards. The School fees cover twelve calendar months and to be paid in advance for 2 months at a time. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls. Fees / Admission charges once paid are not refunded.

Fees must be paid from 1st to 15th of every month, failing which a fine as per direction in the fee-book is to be paid.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM:**

All students must report in complete prescribed school uniform from the very first day of the session. If the specified uniforms are not worn, stern disciplinary action will be taken against the offending students. This rule applies even when the students go out for excursions or visit places of interest conducted by the school.

#### **Pre-Primary :**

**Boys :** L.N. to KG - White Red Dot printed half sleeved shirt, red (prescribed S. Kumar Ambition Deluxe shade No. 205) shorts having two cross pocket with piping. School belt, prescribed socks Black shoes with a strap across and instep.

**Girls :** L.N. to KG - White Red Dot printed Aline frock upto knee length. School belt, prescribed, socks, Black shoes with a strap across and instep. Hair should be neatly tied with black hair clip and red ribbons.

#### **Primary :**

**Boys :** I - V - Off-white half sleeved shirt with check combinations on sleeves and collar, check shorts having two cross pocket with piping.

**Girls :** I - V - Off-white half sleeved shirt with check combinations on sleeves and collar, check box - pleated skirt with inside pocket (right hand side, with chain on the left side) upto the knee, prescribed socks and school belt.

#### **Secondary :**

**Boys :** VI - XII - Off-white half sleeved shirt with check collar and piping on sleeves, check full pant. Belt with school buckle, Black shoes with prescribed socks.

**Girls :** VI - XII - Off-white half sleeves shirt with check collar and piping on sleeves, check skirt with three pleates on each side with box in the middle and inside pocket (right hand side, with chain on the left side) upto knee, with prescribed socks and belt with school buckle.

**Winter :** The Blazer should be cream colour with full size monogram embroidered on the pocket.

P.T. for L.N. to X : House colour track suit, white socks, House Colour Red, Blue, Green, Yellow Belt.

**Winter dress :** The details of winter uniform will intimated by a circular later on.

#### **Book Shop :**

All School books and articles of stationery should be purchased from the school book shop only.

Exercise Books - for the purpose of uniformity students are required to buy exercise books of the standard design bearing the school logo from the school book shop only.

#### **Dress Counter**

The school uniform should be obtained/made ordered from our authorised school tailor only and from no where else in order to avoid problem.

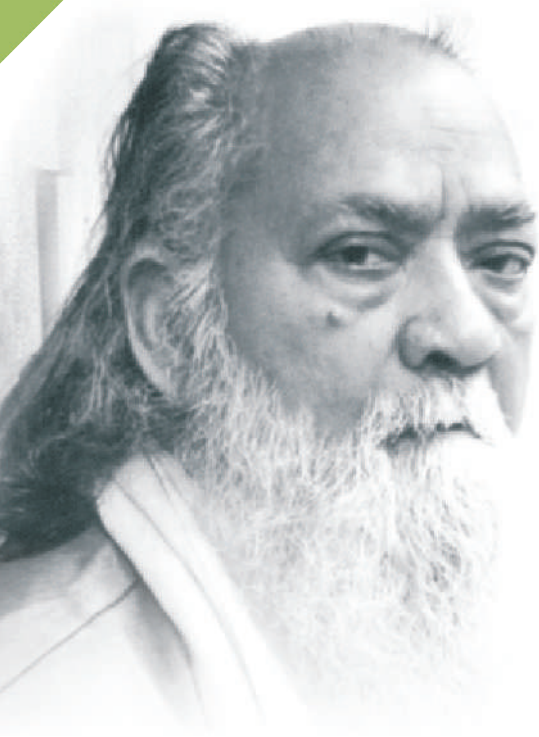

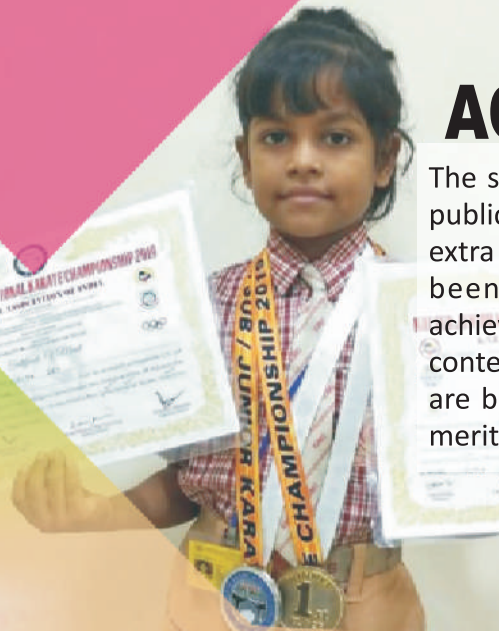

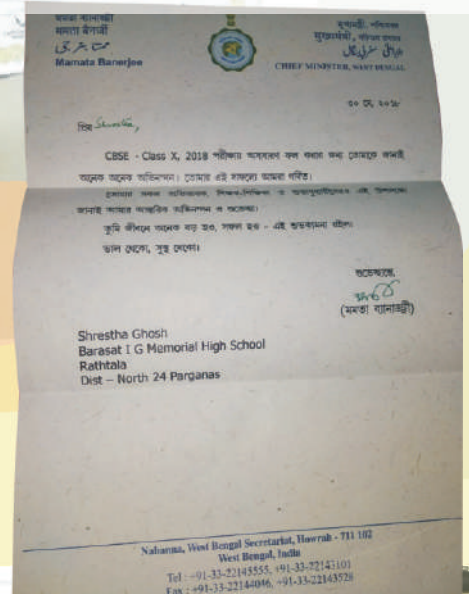
